




- A pedestrian trail connection between the River Walk and San Pedro Creek Culture park



Project Overview

- Project Goals:
 - Preliminary Engineering Report (PER) and cost estimates
 - Evaluate three design concepts:
 - 1) River Walk Level
 - 2) Hybrid Approach
 - 3) Street Level





Scope



- 13 tasks, including:
 - Civil Engineering Design
 - Landscape Architectural Design
 - Architecture & Historical Preservation and Permitting
 - Hydrology & Hydraulics



Schedule Overview

- Kicked-off February 16, 2023
- 60% invited public engagement June 21, 2023
- PER completed in November
- Final PER Public Meeting today





Public Engagement

- Based on feedback from June 21, 2023:
 - Explored an alternative alignment at the River Walk connection
 - Improved project visuals to clarify potential amenities and convey project "flow"
 - Continued engagement with adjacent property owners
 - Adjusted amenities




River Walk Level Design Option

- Design overview:
 - Street level at San Pedro Creek Culture Park
 - Slopes down as the project moves east to River Walk level
 - Bridges built at street level to allow project to pass under Flores, Main and Soledad Streets

A phased approach is presented in the PER

Hybrid Design Option

- Design overview:
 - Created to ensure fully incorporated ADA accessibility
 - Street Level from San Pedro Creek Culture Park to Main Street
 - Bridge built at street level to allow project to pass under Soledad Street

Street Level Option

- Design overview:
 - Street level throughout the project length
 - Elevator proposed at River Walk for ADA accessibility
 - Eliminates retaining walls, bridges and most excavation costs
 - Vehicular and pedestrian interaction at all three street crossings



Technical Recommendations

- Continued landowner and public meetings
- Traffic impact study on Savings Street once bond project is complete
- Economic impact and benefit study
- Explore funding opportunities
- Operations and maintenance discussions
